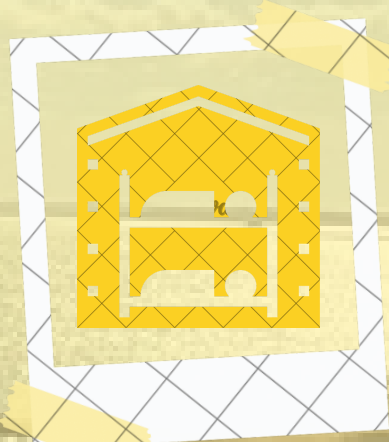

LA GUAJIRA

The Guajira Peninsula is known as the land of the indigenous Wayuu tribe where the wind never stops. Eoletto's Kite Trip offers a memorable expedition to Punta Gallinas to kite in some of the most amazing wind spots in the world: Virgin beaches surrounded by mongroves and a vast desert, really cool travel destination to explore.

The Wayuu locals have started practicing kitesurfing, which allows us to enjoy navigation also in off shore wind conditions.

Local guides, rescue boats and off-road vehicle support ensure that the entire journey is as safe as possible.

Learning about the Wayuu culture, eating their traditional food, sleeping in hammocks under the stars (for those who want to try it) and exploring thousands of their virgin land is a once in a lifetime experience!

T O P S E I T

Punta Gallinas is located at the northernmost point of South America.

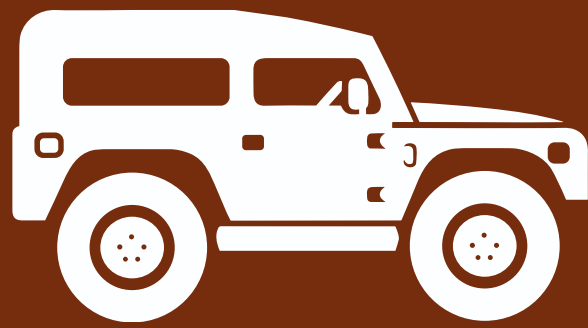
After crossing the vast desert, we reach four beautiful kitesurfing spots.

The first is La Laguna, just a three-minute walk from the Rancheria de Luz Mila. The water is perfectly calm, and the wind blows offshore. From the lagoon, we sail with the wind to the second spot, La Boquita..

La Boquita, a flat water bay with a beautiful long beach. The third place is Punta Aguja, where the sea waves makes marvelous crests of easy navigation. It is open sea. The fourth destination is the Taroa Dunes, this is perfect for those who enjoy big size waves; we take a 4 x 4 car to get there, the place is only for advanced kilters – side shore winds but there are no rescue boats nearby.



DAY 1



6:00 am – Departure from Hotel in Mayapo to Punta Gallinas. Stop in Uribia for coffee, cold drinks and a little stretch.

11:00 am – Arrival at Punta Gallinas, check in at the Luz Mila Ranch, lunch.

3:00 pm – Boat ride to the kite spot, kitesurfing in flat water conditions and kite lessons for beginners.

6:00 pm – Return by boat to the Luz Mila lodge, snack and dinner.



DAY 2



8:00 am Breakfast at the ranch.

9:00 am Boat transfer to the Kitesurf Spot in flat waters. Downwind from La Ensenada to La Boquita. Assistance on the boat at all times.

Lunch at La Enramada de Punta Aguja, hammocks and relaxation. Kitesurfing in La Boquita with flat water. Kitesurfing classes for beginners.

5:00 am Return by boat or car.

7:00 Traditional Yonda & Wayuu Dinner.



DAY 3



8:00 am Breakfast

9:00 am Boat directly to La Ensenada.

Kite practice and morning class

or a wave session at the Dunes of Taroa

1:00 pm Lunch at the spot

2:00 pm depart to Cabo de la Vela

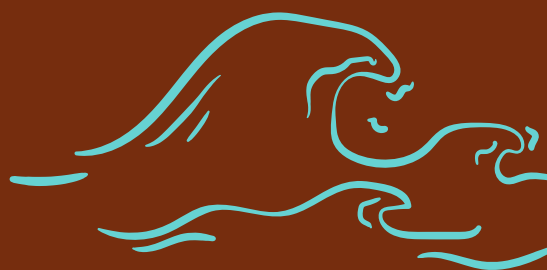
3:00 pm kite session at Cabo de la Vela

5:30 Car trip to the tourist site El Faro to see the sunset.

6:30 pm Return by car to the ranch in Cabo de la Vela. Dinner and end of the day



DAY 4



8:00 Breakfast

9:00 Car ride to Playa Pilon de Azucar.

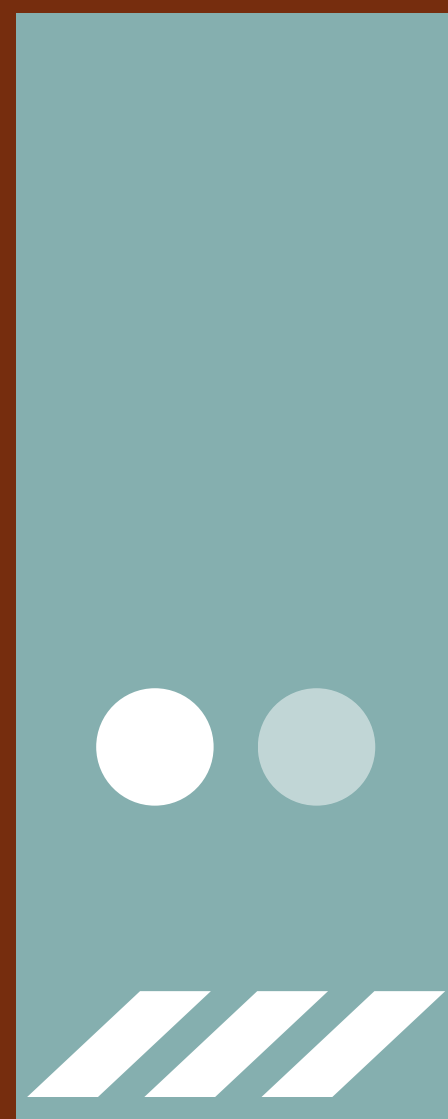
10:30 am Kite Session in Cabo de la Vela.

1.30 pm lunch in Cabo

3:00 pm Return to Riohacha.

 - **Traditional Wayuu night.**

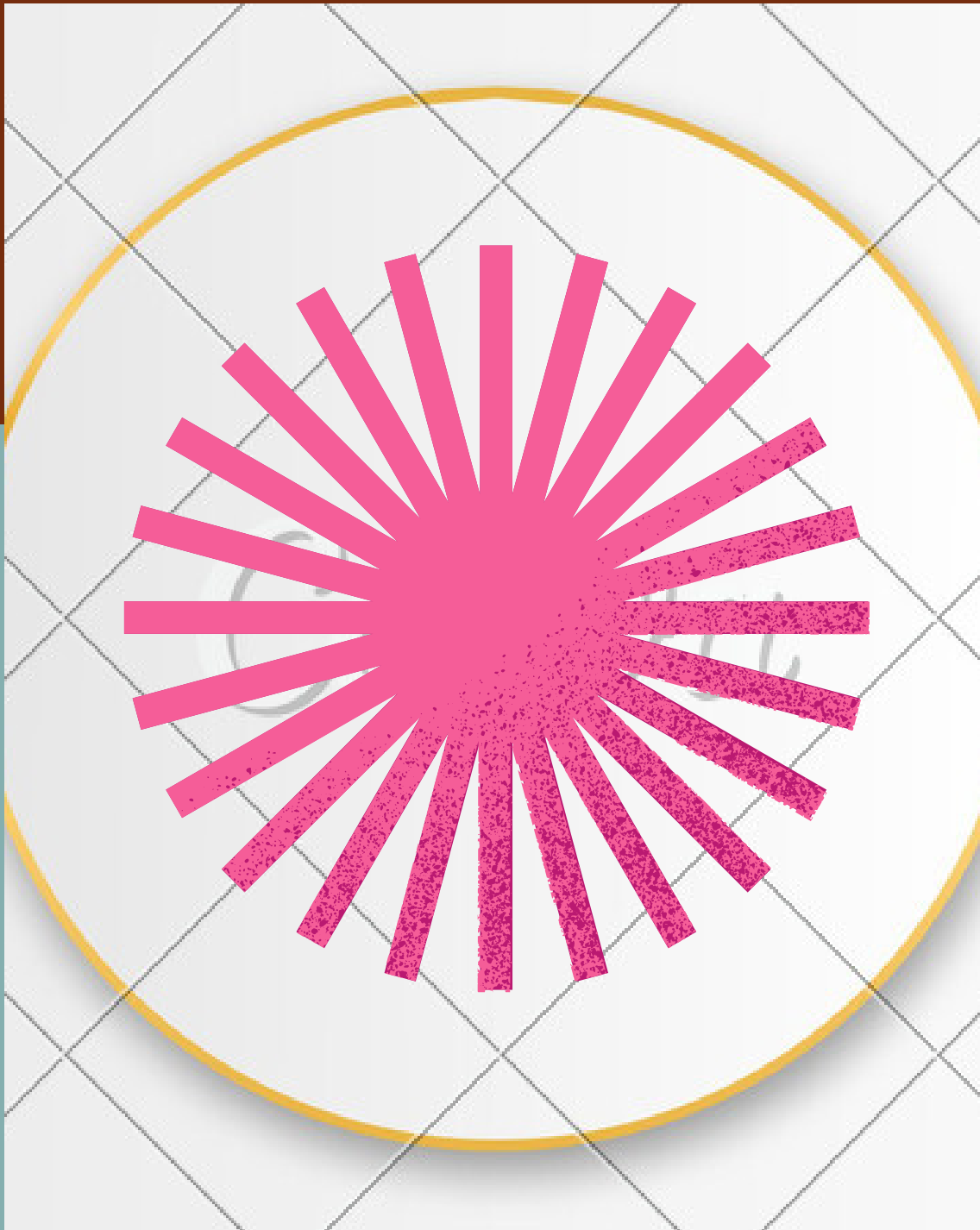
